The plaque will comfortably accommodate 100 letters including spaces over a maximum of 5 lines. A template will be supplied, and a draft copy will be sent to you for approval before work commences on the plaque.

All plaques will be black granite with gold lettering.

I agree to the following terms and conditions of the dedication wall plaque:

- 1. All dedication plaques will be supplied by the council and remain in the council's ownership. During the period of dedication, the authority accepts responsibility for the care of the plaque.
- 2. The dedication is restricted to the plaque alone and no other features, materials, planting, or decoration should be added to the area surrounding the wall. Any additions of this nature will be removed by the council.
- 3. The wording of plaque must be approved by the council and must conform to the specification in the dedication policy.
- 4. The council reserves the right to remove any damaged plaques that it deems to be a hazard. The donator will be informed of any such occurrences and given to opportunity to rectify the situation.
- 5. The dedication is restricted to a 10-year period in the first instance starting from the date the plaque is placed on the wall.
- 6. Any concerns regarding the wall or dedication plaques including damage should be reported to the cemetery service on 01284 757068 immediately.

7. The fixing of screws, hooks nails and plastic binding including strings, wind chimes, etc. to the wall is strictly forbidden. Any additions of this nature will be removed by site staff.
