Rural Vision 2031 Local Plan

Adoption Statement 23 September 2014

In accordance with Regulation 26 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012, notice is hereby given that on 23 September 2014, St Edmundsbury Borough Council adopted the Rural Vision 2031 Local Plan. The plan forms part of the Local Plan for St Edmundsbury. It contains policies covering the period 2014-2031.

The Rural Vision 2031 Local Plan was considered by an independent Planning Inspector as part of a Public Examination, with hearings held between 28 January and 12 February 2014. The Inspector's report was received on 14 July 2014 and concluded that the Plan was 'sound', subject to a number of Main Modifications. The adopted Rural Vision 2031 Local Plan incorporates the recommendations of the Inspector.

Any person who is aggrieved by the adoption of the Rural Vision 2031 Local Plan may make an application to the High Court under Section 113 of the Planning & Compulsory Purchase Act 2004, on the grounds that the document is not within the appropriate power and/or a procedural requirement has not been complied with. Any such application must be made promptly and no later than 6 weeks after the date on which the Rural Vision 2031 Local Plan was adopted, i.e. by **4 November 2014**.
